Our Roundtree Way depot is
going fully electric and will use renewable
electricity to charge each bus overnight.

The powerful batteries - up to six times
more powerful than those in a standard
electric car - allow a bus to
keep going all day.



Each bus produces zero emissions
at the tail pipe, meaning cleaner air for
Norwich. The CO₂ savings, at least 75 tonnes*
per bus per year, will also help in the battle
against climate change.

Our electric buses are smooth and so quiet
that at low speed a sound is made,
warning of their presence.
